






AMBITION WITHOUT ACTION?

1. ACT BEFORE CERTAINTY

Waiting for "perfect data" can lead to unforeseen ecological collapse. The ocean is complex, and uncertainty acts as a risk multiplier.

The SaveOCEAN OS emphasizes the importance of proactive measures rather than waiting for absolute clarity before taking action.



2. STOP FIXING SILOS

We must adopt whole-of-seascape strategies that promote **cross-sector collaboration** and ensure all marine ecosystems are treated as integral parts of a unified system.



3. ONO MORE "PAPER PARKS"

Effective conservation requires measurable biodiversity impacts, not just designated zones. Prioritizing accountability is essential for sustainable marine protections that nurture ecosystems and support communities.

Co-designing strategies with local voices fosters shared stewardship and ensures that solutions are effective and equitable for all stakeholders involved.

Harvest Limits
